Dilley is a Meteorologist / Climatologist and senior research scientist for Global Weather Oscillations

Government agencies say that carbon dioxide levels are rising entirely due to human activity and the burning of fossil fuels. But are they? Professor Dilley will show that today's temperatures and carbon dioxide levels are very close to where they should be based on historical cycles. He will also show that we are sliding into a long-term global cooling cycle. Global Warming begins and ends at the poles—and Global Cooling is now occurring in the Arctic and Antarctic.

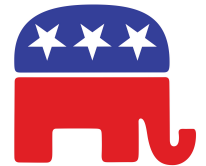


Mike Brakey

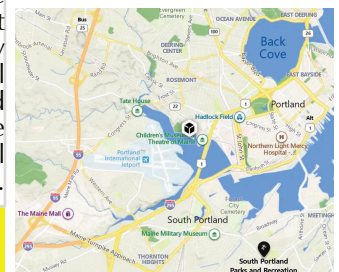
